# Application Share Uses

---

- ❑ Show applications running from your desktop
- ❑ Demonstrate step by step how to use software
- ❑ Teach navigation through a system
- ❑ Show websites and have the participants follow along



# App Share vs. Web Share

---

- ❑ WebShare just loads a webpage
- ❑ Any scrolling or clicking through the presenter does is not displayed to the participants
- ❑ Using AppShare instead to show a webpage in a browser displays any presenter changes
- ❑ Ensures that participants are able to follow as the presenter scrolls or clicks to new pages



# Preparing to use AppShare

---

- ❑ Preload the content and screens you want to share before starting the Live session
- ❑ Size the windows to fit inside of your content area screen
- ❑ Take into account the differing viewing formats and the navigation column added to an archived Live Classroom session
- ❑ Practice beforehand with a TA, colleague, etc.



# While Sharing

---

- ❑ Share a Screen Area instead of a Window or the Full Desktop
- ❑ Click and drag the screen area box to show only what is necessary
- ❑ Keep the area shared to roughly the size of your Content Area, to still be able to monitor the Participant frame and use those features



# While Sharing

---

- ❑ Limit your scrolling behavior. Use deliberate mouse movements only.
- ❑ Periodically check with the participants that they are seeing what you are sharing. Use the Yes/No (check/X) feature if in lecture mode.
- ❑ Monitor the raised hands and text chat to see if a participant has a relevant question you can answer during the lecture or if it can wait.
